

# Baja Emergency Evacuation Membership

Binational Emergency is a dynamic non-profit organization that will get you out of Mexico FAST in case of a medical or life-threatening emergency. Their dedicated bilingual staff will do what is necessary in arranging your safe transport back into the United States via air or ground ambulance. As soon as your call is received, they immediately assist you in obtaining proper medical care while working on your safe return to the United States. By becoming a member, they will have all the tools needed for your safe return.

Binational Emergency Medical Care Committee originated in California and consists of people from the United States and Mexico. The professionals at BEMCC represent the medical field, federal, state and local law enforcement agencies, social workers, consular officials and hospital personnel. They are a well rounded team getting you the most immediate attention and transport available.

The idea was to establish a much needed system of international cooperation designed to help victims of car accidents, fires, floods and man-made or natural disasters. BEMCC also provides medical assistance to needy people from both sides of the California/Baja California border region for any medical emergency including remote assistance.

The card is for single person use only, your companions need to purchase the membership card separately.

How BEMCC Works:

In the case that you are injured needing transport to a US hospital:

1. Call the BEMCC number (local phone, hospital phone, or with a Satellite phone)

2. Give them your GPS coordinates and a general location description (i.e. middle of the desert/name of hospital facility/name of your boat/plane description/or any descriptions that may help them locate you (i.e. 3 red & white motorcycles at the base of the san pedro martir with a silver survival blanket layed out with the injured on top)). Make sure to give them any contact information you can (phone numbers/names).

3. You will be asked for the injured's date of birth and social security number or membership number.

4. Give a concise description of the injury & severity

5. BEMCC will arrange the emergency evacuation. If by helicopter, the coast guard, or other, they will have an ambulance waiting for the remainder of your journey to a US hospital.

6. They will also communicate with your emergency contacts and let them know where they can find you.

Benefits of having the BEMCC card in your wallet:

- Your Binational Membership entitles you to 24 hour emergency evacuation service from Mexico via land or air transport
- Support staff available 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- Only \$45 a year for peace of mind
- Bilingual legal assistance
